

DIRECTIONS TO DRAKES CREEK PARK 161 Indian Lake Blvd Hendersonville, TN 37075

From South (Nashville)

Take I-65 North toward Louisville. Take exit #95 (Vietnam Veterans Blvd – Hwy 386) toward Hendersonville.

Take exit #7 (Indian Lake Blvd / Drakes Creek Rd). Turn right off exit. Go straight through four stoplights.

Turn right into park at edge of Demo's Restaurant parking lot.

OR

Take I-65 North toward Louisville. Take exit #95 (Vietnam Veterans Blvd – Hwy 386) toward Hendersonville.

Take exit #3 (Hwy 31E) toward Hendersonville. Follow 31E (Main St / Gallatin Rd) through town to

stoplight #9 (Cherokee Rd / North Park Rd). Turn left at stoplight (by Sweet Ce Ce's). Follow road into park.
